

If you have one of these conditions your local pharmacist can provide advice and treatment for most people; please ask for more information

- Acute cough
- Acute fever
- Acute bacterial conjunctivitis
- Acute pain/ earache/ headache/temperature
- Athlete's foot
- Bites, stings, and allergies
- Cold sores
- Cold and 'flu

- Constipation
- Cystitis
- Diarrhoea

How does it work?

Your consultation will be with a qualified pharmacist in a private room if needed. The pharmacist can supply you with some medicines, where appropriate, and any advice you require.

How much does it cost?

The consultation is free, and if the pharmacist agrees that you need medicines, they will be supplied free-of-charge for people who get free prescriptions.
